South Dayton Dance Theatre (SDDT)

- Often referred to as the "Company" it is a separate legal entity from the school (South Dayton School of Dance)
- Non-profit, Performing dance company, started in 1986 by Ms. Elizabeth Karns
- Managed by a board of directors
- Miss Erin is the Artistic Director
- supports a company of 46 dancers age 9 and older.
- Provides performing opportunities for SDSD students through their annual Nutcracker
- Who you pay for all Nutcracker related expenses

Auditions & Casting Information

- Students do not audition for a specific role but are matched to a role by our Artistic Staff based on their skill level
 - o as students are assigned roles by skill level, sometimes a dancer will be cast in a role for more than one year
- The cast list will be posted to the SDDT website (www.sddt.org) on the Sunday following auditions.
 - We will notify you via BAND when the cast list is posted.
- The Artistic Staff takes great care in the casting of our Nutcracker and therefore once the list is posted, casting is final and no changes will be made.

Rehearsal Schedule and Information

- Please note that ALL rehearsals are MANDATORY
 - Dancers are permitted one excused absence from a rehearsal as long as that date was provided on the audition form
 - o If you forgot, you can still give us this date by the end of the day today and be excused
 - Student illness or family emergencies are also considered excused, provided that we are notified prior to the absence.
 - Cannot use your excused absence for an in-studio dress rehearsal or any event at the Masonic Center December 5th, 6th, or 7th
- Rehearsals will begin as early as Monday 9/8/25
 - o for non-company dancers, rehearsal is once per week from now until the end of October and then 3 times a week during the month of November leading up to our performances
- For the rehearsal schedule, please check the SDDT Call Board regularly
 - o www.sddt.org/call-board
 - o this is also available on the BAND app
- We have a DRAFT of the non-company dancer rehearsal schedule for your reference, however these dates can and will change depending on the needs of the production.
- Some additional rehearsals may be required when we are ready to put together large chunks of our show prior to dress rehearsals (ex. All Snow Scene, Party Scene, etc.)



Parent Communication & BAND App

- for communication regarding non-company participation in Nutcracker we use the BAND app.
- It is required that at least one parent/guardian join the BAND for Nutcracker for ease of communication
- BAND is an app where Parents and SDDT Moderators can communicate in an open forum. Through the app you can ask questions, store files, privately chat with moderators, sign up for volunteer opportunities and more!
- BAND is our main method of communication for Nutcracker, however some information regarding important forms or events will also be emailed to you.

Volunteer Requirement

- Each dancer is required to have a parent/guardian volunteer to supervise non-company dancers for one time slot at an in-studio rehearsal and one time slot during our dress-rehearsals or performances during our show weekend.
 - If you have 2 dancers participating you are responsible for double the requirement
- During In-studio rehearsals, male or female parents are permitted to supervise as dancers are not changing clothes.
- During Dress-rehearsals and performances, female parents only will be eligible to supervise as dancers will be changing clothes.
- During this time it is encouraged for dancers to find quiet ways to occupy themselves as this is training for being in the dressing room during the show where dancers can be heard from the stage if loud.

Fees (Required & Optional)

- the ONLY required fee for participation in Nutcracker is the \$100 audition fee which covers rehearsal time, choreographer, costume rental, and now includes the Nutcracker T-shirt for all dancers.
- Tickets to the show are sold separately.
 - o Tickets typically go on sale November 1st
- Merchandise Form (usually sent out late September and Due October 10th)
 - Memory bears
 - These bears are an exact replica of your dancer's costume and will serve as a sweet reminder of each role they had as they grow!
 - Nutcracker T-shirts (NOW INCLUDED IN AUDITION FEE for all dancers)
 - The Nutcracker t-shirt will be a dark green, long-sleeved shirt that comes in Youth Medium-Youth Large, Adult Small-Adult XXL. The back will include the SDSD non-company cast names arranged alphabetically. Additional shirts for family members available through the Merchandise form.
 - Personal Shout-Outs
 - A personal shout-out will be displayed in the final product of our Nutcracker Video Recording either before during intermission.
 - o Business Advertisements in Program
 - We need these in order to have professionally printed programs. Please ask local businesses you know well.
- Flowers and Nutcracker Videos will also be available for order closer to our show in November
